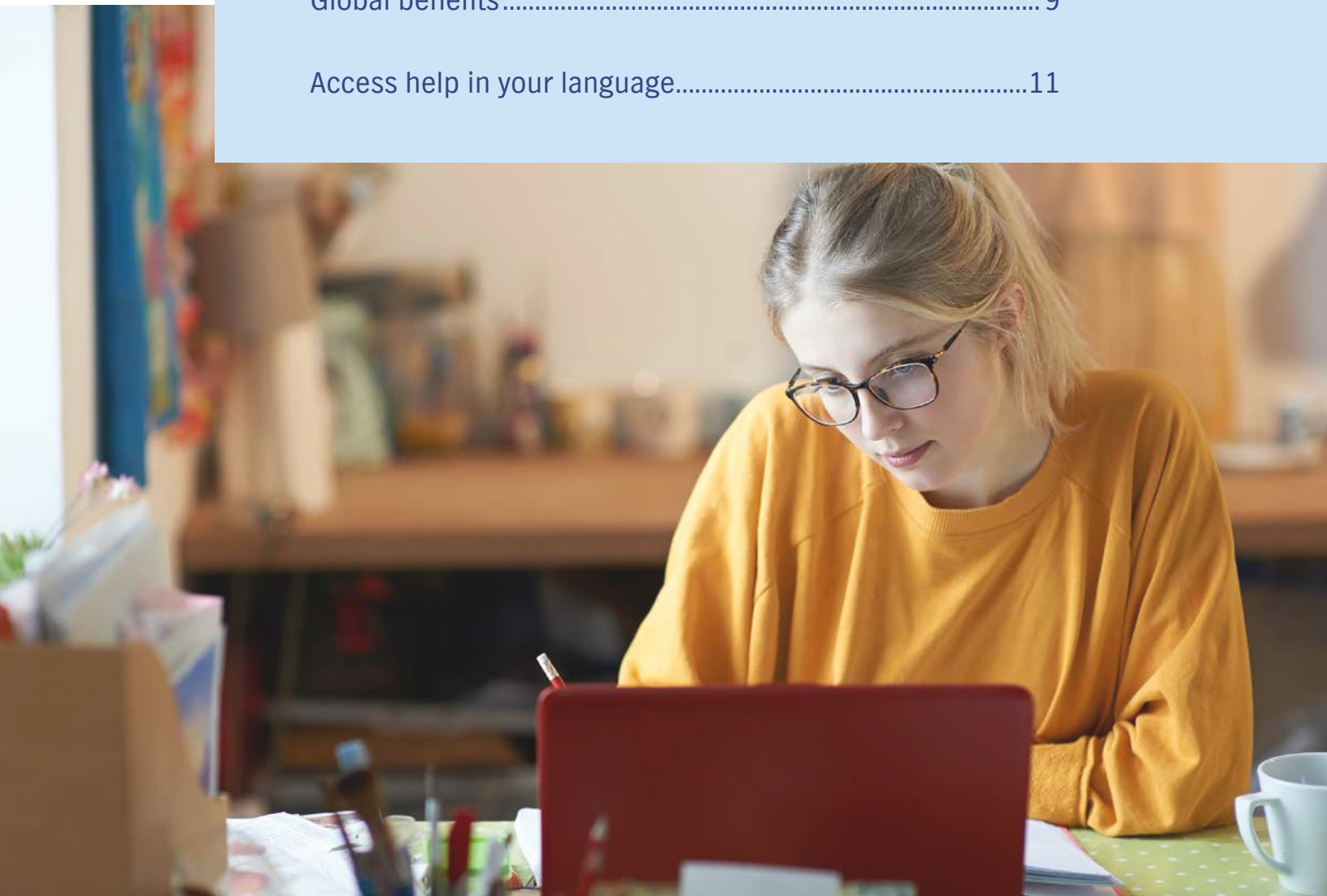

Who is eligible?

- All domestic undergraduate, graduate, Law, and Jesuit School of Theology students in a degree seeking program who are enrolled at least halftime in their school or college are automatically enrolled unless proof of comparable coverage is provided by completing an online waiver form by the deadline.
- All F-1 and J-1 Visa students, regardless of number of units, are required to have insurance and are automatically enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan.
- Dependents of insured students are not eligible for the Student Health Insurance Plan.
