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General Information

Am I Eligible

Enrollment in a health insurance plan is required for all students at Albertus Magnus College. To ensure compliance with this policy, all Full-Time Domestic Students are automatically enrolled in and billed on their tuition bill for the Student Health Insurance Plan unless proof of comparable insurance coverage is documented. Documentation is provided by completing a waiver form identifying the in-force comparable coverage and submitting it by the posted deadline. If a form is not submitted by the deadline, the student will remain enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan for the policy year.

International Students taking 1 or more credit hours are automatically enrolled and billed for the Student Health Insurance Plan and do not have the option to waive coverage.

Dependents

Dependents are eligible.

How Do I Waive/Enroll?

To Waive Coverage or Enroll Dependents:

1. Visit www.gallagherstudent.com/Albertus.
2. Under 'Profile', click on LOG IN. **First Time Users:** You will need to complete the registration form.
3. Under 'Plan Summary', click on the green "ENROLL" or yellow "WAIVE" button.
4. Follow the instructions to complete the respective form. Click 'Submit' to complete the process.
 - a. If enrolling, you will receive a confirmation email.
 - b. If waiving the insurance, have your current health insurance ID card ready, as you will need this information in order to complete the waiver form. You will receive an email with a reference number; please note and keep this information for your records.

The deadline to Waive/Enroll for Annual coverage is 09/08/2024.

Exclusion Disclaimer: Any exclusion in conflict with the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act or any state-imposed requirements will be administered to comply with the requirements of the federal or state guideline, whichever is more favorable to You.

The Certificate does not cover Loss nor provide benefits for any of the following, except as otherwise provided by the benefits of the Certificate and as shown in the Schedule of Benefits.

General Exclusions

- **International Students Only** - Eligible expenses within Your Home Country or country of origin that would be payable or medical Treatment that is available under any governmental or national health plan for which You could be eligible.
